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THE PURPOSE OF WHBTC

World Harvest Bible Training Centre is a centre of excellence for ministry training designed to help fulfil the Great Commission found in Matthew 28:18-20:

“And Jesus came and spoke unto them, saying, all power is given unto Me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.”

Our purpose is to train highly skilled men and women to fulfil the Great Commission. At WHBTC, we teach the practical side as well as the spiritual side of the ministry. For this reason WHBTC is called a training centre rather than a bible school. Our purpose goes beyond just ‘educating’ the mind, we are training our students both spiritually and naturally to apply the principles of God’s Word, not only to benefit their personal life, but to fulfil their life calling.

WHBTC’s course selection deals with all facets of life and ministry. We teach students how to recognize the call of God and to minister effectively in the office/gifting that God has placed on their life.

Classroom instruction is enriched by the ministerial experience of our core instructors as well as the invaluable input from guest ministers.

The best training is through both precept and example. Students will become aware of, and familiar with, the manifestations and the workings of the Holy Spirit and together with World Harvest Bible Church, WHBTC provides an atmosphere whereby students can see in operation both the natural and the supernatural aspects of various ministries.

WHBTC emphasizes the love of God in demonstration, the anointing and the presence of the Holy Spirit, the commitment to the integrity of God’s word, and the necessity for unity of vision and purpose.



Vision, Mission & 10 Key Aims

Vision

World Harvest Bible Training Centre is a centre of excellence for ministry training with a special focus on those called to Spiritual Leadership.

Mission

Through the integrity of God's Word and the Power of the Spirit, as well as very practical hands on training, we are equipping highly skilled labourers for the global harvest of this generation.

10 Key Aims

1. **Word: To** Emphasize the Integrity of God's Word.
2. **Holy Spirit: To** create an atmosphere for the Holy Spirit to move and minister, enabling the students to experience and learn from the move of God's Spirit.
3. **Partnership: To** work in co-operation with church leaders and others whenever possible.
4. **Variety: To** expose students to various gifts in the Body of Christ so that they can learn from, and experience, a variety of ministry gifts and anointings.
5. **Useable: To** ensure that every student receives the most practical training through hands on experience and exposure to experts and professionals from the widest possible that will give students the tools they need to be a success.



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6. **World:** To expose every student to opportunities for developing a global vision and heart for missions.
7. **Destiny:** To assist students in discovering their God ordained purpose and aid them in accomplishing it.
8. **Character:** To emphasise, teach and model character since it is the most important characteristic of a minister. We want our graduates to be known for their love, honour and servant's heart.
9. **Excellence:** By example we aim to impart into every student a value for providing all things excellent.
10. **Faith:** To instil the spirit of faith, which pervades this ministry to our students so that our graduates will be imprinted with the truth that all things are possible to those who believe.



YEAR ONE CLASSES - split over the two years at night:

A. Balancing Family and Ministry: Minister's Family

This course is designed to help students understand the importance of keeping the proper structure of importance and balance in maintaining healthy families and ministries.

B. Bible Doctrines

Throughout this class you will study the different fundamental doctrines in the Bible such as Salvation, Angels and Demons, the atonement, what sin is etc

C. Biblical Economics & Stewardship 1 & 2

In this course the student will learn the Biblical principles that govern prosperity and success. An in-depth study of the Biblical laws of prosperity will be examined. The student will also gain insight into the proper balance between the spiritual and natural principles that determine success and true prosperity.

D. Biblical Perspective & Supportive Ministries

This course will help students recognize the importance of supportive ministries in the maintaining and functioning of the local church.

E. Bible Interpretation & Homiletics

This course is designed to teach the students an overall understanding of what the Bible is and why it is the foundation of our faith. The students will also learn how to properly interpret and apply the scriptures.



F. Christology: A study of Christ through the Old and New Testaments

This foundational course is designed to prove through the scriptures the authenticity of Jesus as the Messiah. Students will also learn the purpose of Christ's work on the earth and His present day ministry as the risen Saviour.

G. Christ Our Healer 1 & 2

This course is designed to establish a Biblical basis to validate God's willingness to heal all, to determine from the scriptures why some people fail to receive healing, and to equip students to minister God's healing power to others.

H. Church History

This course is designed to give the student the history of the Pentecostal and general church history since the book of Acts to the 20th century.

I. Disciplines of the Christian life 1 & 2

This course is designed to help students develop and to learn about Christian Lifestyle which is not based on their personal or cultural backgrounds but on the word of God dealing with the areas of submission and humility and the love command of Jesus.

J. Ecclesiology

This course will help students know the roll and purpose of the church in the life of every believer. It will also help students see the importance of the church in society and church government,



L. (The) Grace Life

This course explores the subject of the Grace and the different aspects of God and how to apply it in our Lives.

M. Holy Spirit & His Gifts 1 & 2

This course is designed to teach the student who the Holy Spirit is and how to follow His leadings. Students will also learn about the gifts of the Spirit, their purpose, and how they should be used in the body of Christ.

N. How to be led by the spirit: God's Plan for Leading His People

In this class the students will learn the principle ways that God leads and directs His people today as well as learning how to develop sensitivity to the leading of the Holy Spirit

O. Humility: Submission and Authority

This Video class by Reverend Keith Moore formerly of Rhema Bible Training Center in Tulsa introduces you

to the Biblical perspective of Humility and what it truly means to be humble.

P. Prepare to Preach: An introduction to preaching including preaching lab

In this class you will study the basic principles of Homiletics and will be given an opportunity to prepare a short message which you may give in class.

Q. Life of Honour

This class examines the subject of Honour and Christian Ethics and how we can apply the principles in our every day lives
